The Northern Sierra Air Quality Management District's Hearing Board will hold a Variance Hearing to consider a petition by American Renewable Power (ARP, a biomass-fired power plant in Loyalton, CA) to extend the compliance date for a variance previously issued for the period March 5, 2019 until December 1, 2019. The variance would allow a required source test (emissions measurement) to be postponed until no later than March 4, 2020, in order to give ARP additional time to procure sufficient representative biomass to perform the test.
